<b>Children &amp; Young People Plan reports</b>	<p>Andy Chartres (YOT) gave an overview of prevention programmes for Jan-Mar 2009. VCS well represented here with Catch22 YIP and IIP, and Youth Options, Motiv8 and Wheatsheaf YSDF.</p> <p>John Bridge (SCC) gave a report on YCAP for us to review before submission to the CYP Trust.</p>	<p>Format to be followed for all reports for submission to the board.</p>
<b>CYP Workforce Strategy</b>	<p>Hilary Kelly (SCC) came to update us on the 2007-10 strategy. The function and membership of the Integrated Workforce Programme Board (IWPB) is being refined and an outline of the structure and where IWPB fits was discussed. A rep was requested from the MAPC sub group but this was put on hold pending clarity on structure and terms of reference etc.</p> <p>It was highlighted that the training would be open to the VCS but how this would be funded was raised. We suggested that this could be dependent on the individual organisations, for example if they were staffed purely by volunteers. We also suggested a match funding model.</p> <p>It was also raised that the VCS operate in all areas of the childrens workforce, and this wasn't clear in the DCSF 2020 CYP Workforce strategy.</p>	
<b>Performance Data</b>	<p>We reviewed the 43 NI's of interest to the MAPC and AEW subgroups.</p> <p>Good results have been achieved in reduction of first time entrants to the criminal justice system and rate of under 18 conceptions.</p> <p>A number of targets are perception based or have specific cut-off dates and these need to be made clear.</p>	
<b>Commissioning Strategy</b>	<p>We reviewed the draft strategy for commissioning and procurement of targeted youth support (aged 5 to 19). A few minor amendments were suggested. The key is the mapping exercise which needs to take place May-July to identify current provision and gaps.</p> <p>A short term Task &amp; Finish Group will be set up and requires VCS representation.</p>	<p>Input from Alliance required. Need to be informed of mapping exercise.</p> <p>A current rep from a subgroup required.</p>

	The length of contract was discussed as it indicates 2 years, which is very short for commissioned services (others have 2+2). Will be followed up with procurement.
