The Role of the LADO Thursday 14th November 2019 12.00-2.00pm Committee Room 1	This session will give you an understanding of the role LADO plays in investigations around people who work in regulated activity (with children) and offer a chance for attendees to consider scenarios in which LADO might become involved.
